As at the end of February 2018, Waverley has a housing list of 1489 applicants.

Table 1 shows the bedroom needs of these applicants; Table 2 shows that there were 105 properties relet during the period, and the ethnicity group of successful applicants; Table 3 shows the bedroom sizes of the 105 properties relet; Table 4 shows in which areas of our housing stock, the 105 properties were in. Finally, Table 5 shows that 40 out of the 105 applicants rehoused (38%), had a priority need. This evidences that you do not require to be in priority need to be successful for one of our homes.

For the 105 successful applicants, It took an average of 4 months from their registering on our housing list to being rehoused.
